


2015 Aber-Days

Optional: A sesquicentennial medal may be earned by participants. The requirements for the sesquicentennial medal include:

- 1. Participate in the 5 mile road march from the 1860s Wild Rice River ford to Fort Abercrombie State Historic Site, and the parade through the Town of Abercrombie. Exemptions or adaptations may be made for handicapped and elderly participants.
- 2. Participate in the Aber-Days activities at Fort Abercrombie State Historic Site.
- 3. Participants pay \$20 pre-registration.
